## INTRODUCTION

The evolution of *Records of English Court Music* has resulted in an arrangement which is not as ordered as one would wish. If a revised edition is ever produced (perhaps in an electronic as well as a printed medium), the opportunity can then be taken to re-structure the whole enterprise. It is my aim to continue to monitor the material, revising, correcting and expanding it as circumstances allow.

In the meantime, it is hoped that this cumulative index will simplify searches. To take account of chronology, as far as is practicable, entries are compiled using the following sequence of volumes: VII, VI, IV, III, I, II, V, VIII. The Subject Index has undergone considerable revision and re-assessment, but it is never easy to meet all requirements. Places and persons have been combined in a single index. Most of the longer entries here have been broken down under subject headings, but in the course of work on these I came to the conclusion that the exercise was something of a mixed blessing and scaled down my original intentions. Nevertheless, in these cases the current arrangement is probably more helpful than multiple lines consisting only of figures.

The opportunity has been taken to present a full list of all errors currently known, and I am grateful to friends and colleagues for notifying me of many of these. I have made two separate lists: (a) errors in the text (excluding minor typing slips resulting merely in mis-spellings or wrong use of upper/lower case); (b) errors in the index pages. The (b) corrections have been incorporated in the present volume. In taking account of all volumes, occasional re-assessment has been made regarding the indexing of some persons, and frequently [I] [II] etc. has had to be added to identify people with the same name.

I cannot conclude this enterprise without expressing again my warmest thanks to all those who have laboured in the various repositories and libraries to provide the raw material for the search, and to my many friends and colleagues who have supported and encouraged me on the way.
