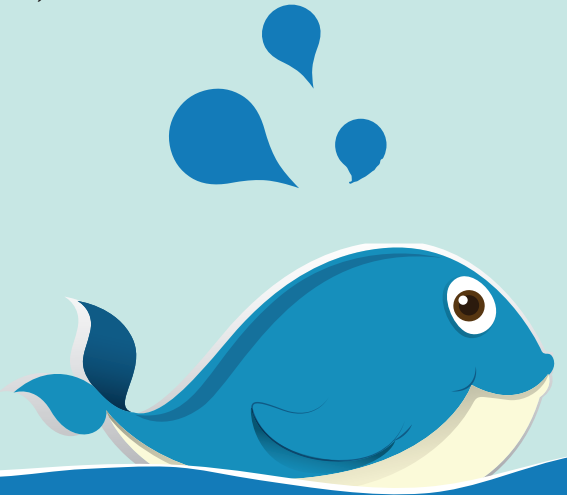

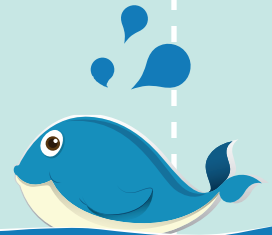

FUN FACTS ABOUT SHARKS

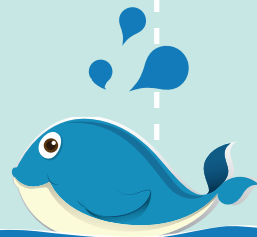

FACT 1

SHARKS DON'T HAVE BONES

Sharks don't have any bones inside their bodies. Neither do their "cousins" rays and skates, which more than likely evolved from sharks millions of years ago.



Instead of bones, they have cartilage, similar to the cartilage in our noses. It's very strong, but less dense than bones and much more flexible.
